

## RoxieReading A Scope and Sequence

The sequence of lessons is designed to allow students to construct words with the sounds they have learned. Once students have some phonemic awareness and know the basic alphabet and sounds they represent, they are able to build words using the individual white boards, letter tiles, or magnetic letters. Students use the same sequence the brain uses in processing words. They hear the sounds in a spoken word, choose the letters that represent those sounds, and then spell the word.
